

Careers in Education

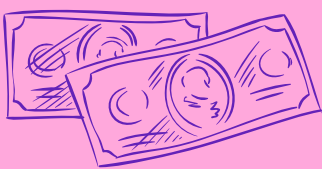

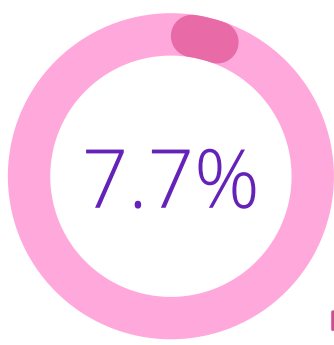

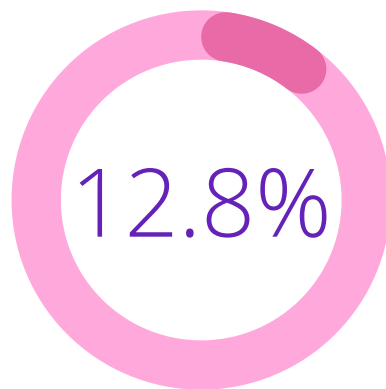
Projected Job

Year



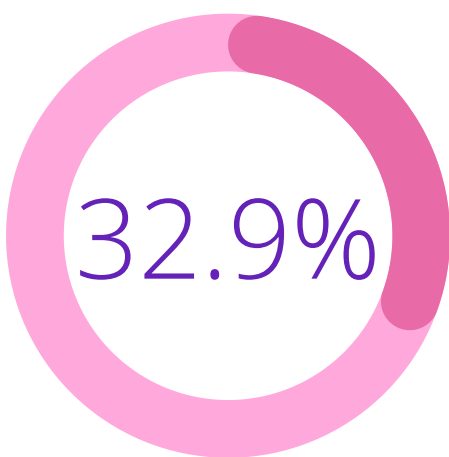

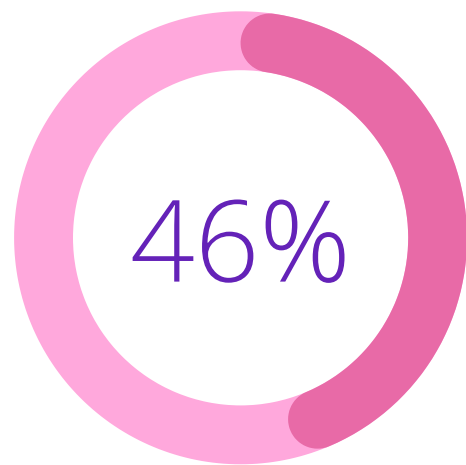
People in these careers with high school education



People in these careers with some college or two-year degrees



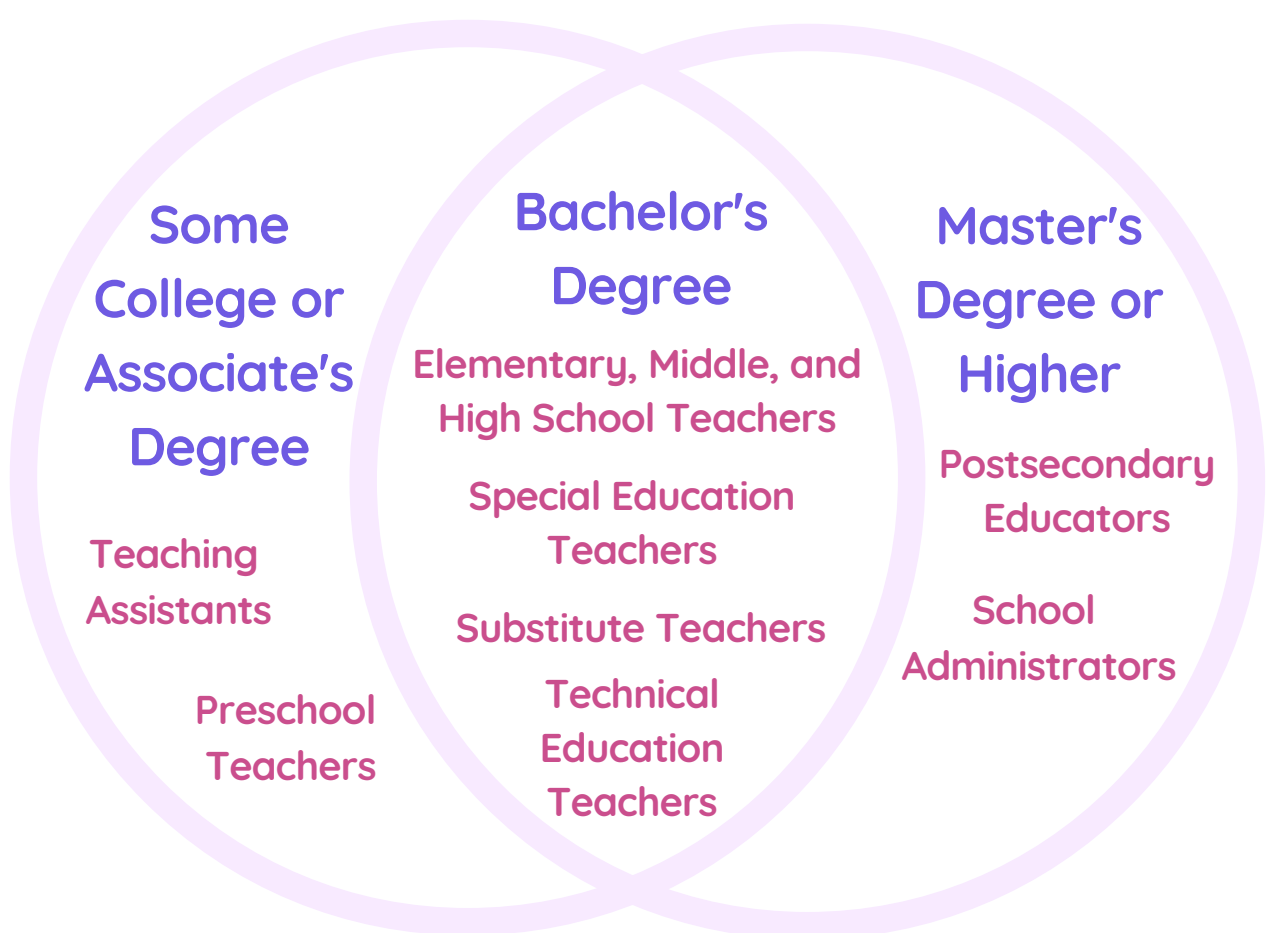
People in these careers with four-year degrees
