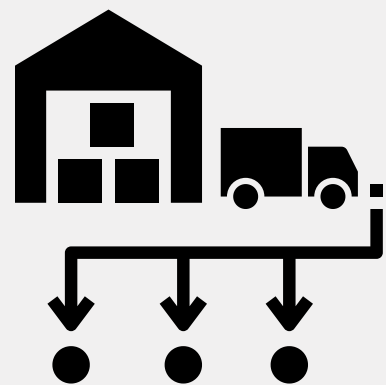

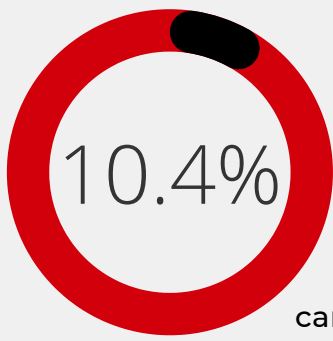

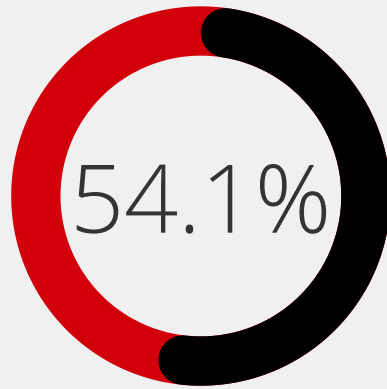
PROJECTED JOB OPENINGS PER YEAR



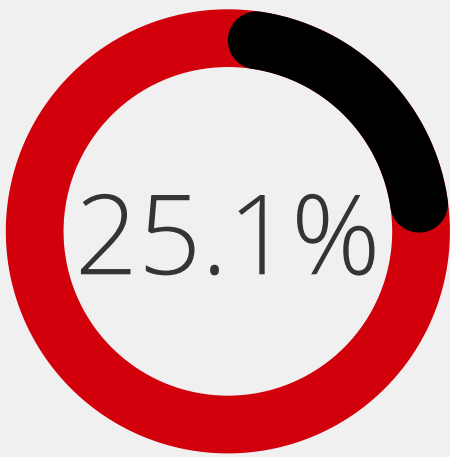

People in these careers with less than a high school education



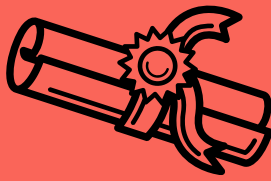
People in these careers with high school education



People in these careers with certificates, some college, or associate's degrees

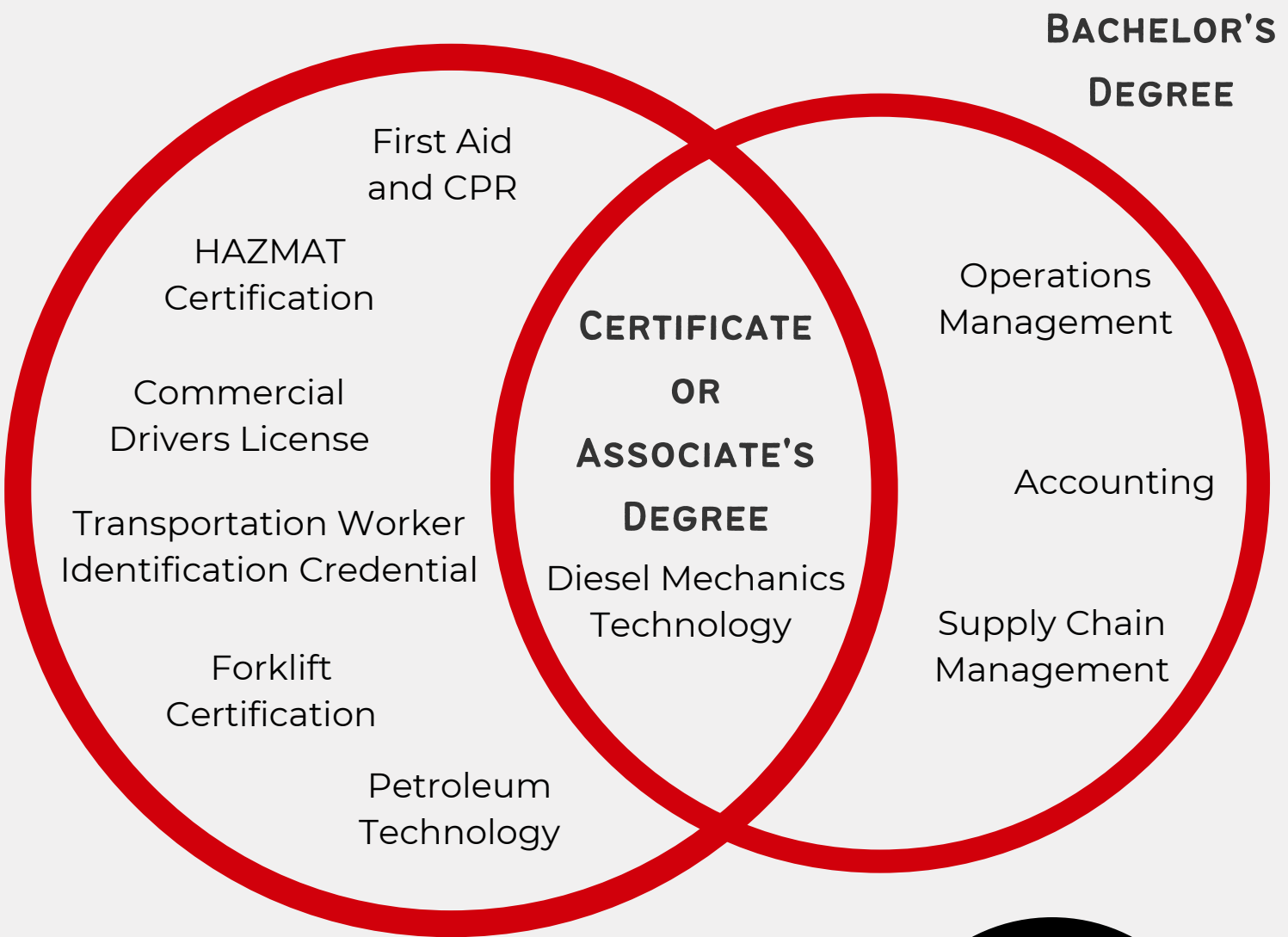


People in these careers with bachelor's degrees or higher
