In the 2025-2026 school year, the Luzerne Learns to Work program aims to:

- Engage all 12 school districts in Luzerne County in either teacherfacilitated or asynchronous student participation
- Provide access and awareness to at least 6,000 students across the County
- Give any business and organization in Luzerne County the ability provide student work-based learning experiences to grow their own sustainable workforce pipeline
- Award scholarships to students to support their next steps in education, totaling \$10,000

STREAMLINED CAREER EXPLORATION FOR LUZERNE COUNTY STUDENTS

Luzerne Learns to Work is an innovative educational program that provides Luzerne County high school students with a process and platform to explore career pathways, workforce development tools, and local industry career pipelines. Through the use of this program, students are empowered to explore potential career pathways through free access to EBSCOlearning and Metrix Learning, local workforce and career development tools, opportunities with local higher education institutions, work-based learning experiences with local companies, and scholarship opportunities for participating seniors. Awareness of these resources builds a pipeline of talent filtered into local industries, ensures that students get early exposure to our community, and produces more qualified talent retained to fill jobs in our most in-demand industries.


